

Week 2: God as our Creator

What did we learn about last week? (Wait for responses). Last week we learned that God's Word is the bible. We learned that the bible is true and it is not a made up story. God wants to talk to us and the bible tells us about Him. The bible also tells us how much God loves us. We will see in a couple weeks just how much He loves each one of us!

When I open the bible and read the very first verse (Genesis 1:1), I read that God made everything! Everything we see in our world was made by God. It says, ***In the beginning God made the Heavens and the Earth.***

God is great and powerful. All He had to do was speak words and everything was made. It is amazing that He made everything in 6 days! (Genesis 2:1-3)

On the sixth day He made people. Genesis 1:26-27 tells us we are made in His image. How many of you have a pet at home? Are you glad that God made pets so that you can have one at home? Do you know that we are more like God than anything else He has made? The bible tells us in Psalm 139:14 that we are wonderfully made by God.

Since we are made in His image, this allows us to be able to have a divine relationship with God. Also, since He created us, we therefore belong to Him. Because we belong to Him, we then possess the potential for fellowship with God. Nothing else God has ever created, besides man, have the potential to have fellowship with God. If you have a pet, your pet is not able to talk and pray to God, but you can!

God made you the way He wanted you to be, and God does not make any mistakes. He can't because He is good and all He makes is good (Gen 1:31).

In closing, every one of us is created by God in His image. By being created in His image, it is then possible for every person to be able to worship and serve God with our lives (animals cannot do this).
