

Week 7: Recapping what we learned

For this final week, you will be recapping what you have shared with your team over the course of the season. It is a brief summary, so please feel free to emphasize certain points of the gospel that you feel your team might not be clear about. You may want to have them ask questions to you about anything they still don't fully understand.

Summary:

Week 1: The bible is the Word of God, and everything in it is entirely true. It is not like some fictional book that has made up stories, but it is the inerrant and infallible Word of God so every word is true! It is a book we can trust in because it is from a God who cannot lie (**Titus 1:2**).

Week 2: God created everything! Every one of us is created by God in His image. By being created in His image, it is then possible for every person to be able to worship and serve God with our lives. God did not make any mistakes, so you are exactly how God wanted you to be!

Week 3: Every one of us is a sinner. God allows us to make choices, and when we make choices that are against the Word of God, this makes God unhappy and this is called sin. God does not allow any sin into His heaven, so we need another way to be able to spend eternity with God.

Week 4: In God's perfect timing, God sent His one and only Son, Jesus Christ, into the world. To show how much God loves us, He had His Son, Jesus, come and die for each one of us in order to take away our sins and place our sins on Himself (**John 3:16**). So if we truly believe that Jesus died for our sins *personally* then we can have confidence that God now sees us as righteous, since Jesus has taken away our sins and has placed it upon Himself!

Week 5: Eternal life is a *free* gift. It is not something that can be "earned" by doing a bunch of "good" things. We cannot ever do enough good in order for us to be seen as righteous by God. The *only* thing we can do is believe and trust alone in Jesus Christ that he truly was sent down to earth to live a sinless life, and die on a cross for our sins. It is faith alone in Christ alone!

Week 6: If you have trusted in Jesus Christ for your salvation, you should then want to grow in your faith. Your desire should be to become more like Jesus each and every day (although we will obviously never attain this). Out of gratitude for what Jesus did for you personally, you will want to please him with your lives, and make decisions that are honoring to God.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
